ART IS MOVING

On March 16, 2017, SunRail unveiled the Art Is Moving coach – a privately-funded roving art gallery aboard SunRail passenger coach #3005. Initially envisioned by artist Nicki Drumb of Orlando, this project provides a visually stimulating, vibrant and community-based experience for SunRail passengers. The first run was purposely scheduled for the day prior to the popular Winter Park Sidewalk Art Festival. The theme: "We're All Connected."

"The Art Community really came together," said Steve Olson, FDOT District 5 Public Information Manger, "and the initial reaction from SunRail passengers has been extraordinary."

34 passenger windows were covered with perforated art on both the interior and exterior, to provide passengers with an art gallery

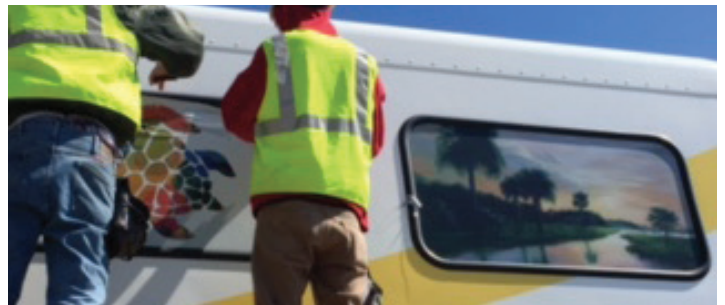


experience inside and out. Additionally, two interior partitions were covered on both sides with four additional pieces. Artists from Orange, Osceola, Seminole, Volusia and Polk counties are all represented in the collection; the youngest artist is 12 years old.

SunRail operations is currently running the Art is Moving coach car eight times per day. The art car will be part of select trains running in the morning, afternoon and evening.
