SunRail Provides Service for Orlando's Two Major Bowl Games

SunRail rang in the New Year with special service for the Citrus Bowl on January 1, 2018. Normally, January 1 is a federal holiday that SunRail observes, but this year, our amazing operations team felt that we could serve our community with service to and from the Citrus Bowl for college football fans as a special service to our Central Florida community.

Even though it was cold and rainy, hundreds of fans used SunRail to get to and from the game. A total of 20 trains moved people to and from the game between 8:00am and 7:30pm. At the LYNX Central Station, LYNX busses served as free shuttles for the last mile connection to the Citrus Bowl."

"What a great day for SunRail," said Nicola Liquori, SunRail CEO. "We were able to transport people safely to and from the game and provide fans a fun way to travel to the stadium. For many, this was their first trip on SunRail. We heard so much great feedback from our travelers and were glad to be able to provide this special service."

Fares

Reloadable SunCards

SunCards have a one-time cost of \$5 and can carry one Travel Plan as well as hold a Prepaid Value.

Travel Plans – Travel Plans give you the freedom to ride on SunRail as many times as you want for 7, 30 or 365 consecutive calendar days after you first Tap On. These plans provide significant savings over a Single-Day ticket.

Prepaid Value - Similar to a debit card, your fare is deducted based on the distance traveled on your trip, and funds can be added to your card as often as needed. Passengers who purchase a SunCard with Prepaid Value also receive a 10% bonus when funds are loaded onto the card.


Discounts
